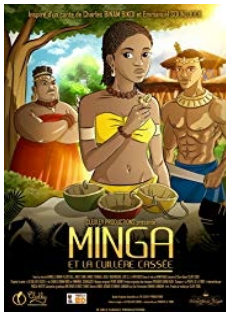


En sortant de l'école – Jacques Prévert

A furious Mami Kaba then chases her away from the house, asking her to find the only identical spoon hidden by her late mother. An adventurous journey then begins for Minga in the forest.

In a small French town, the local postman, scatterbrained François, spends his working hours casually delivering the mail, while the subject of the townsfolk's teasing. When a traveling carnival arrives in town, François is goaded into watching a film about the efficiency of the U.S. Postal Service. Inspired by the footage, François sets out on his bicycle to become just like the mail carriers in the United States.

Neïla, a girl of Algerian descent raised in a housing project, dreams of becoming a lawyer. Arriving at the great Parisian university Assas, she is confronted to Pierre Mazard, a professor known for his provocations and racial slurs. To redeem himself, the latter agrees to prepare Neïla for the prestigious contest of eloquence. Both cynical and demanding, Pierre could become the mentor she needs ... But they must both overcome their prejudices.
