Recommended level: A2+ and higher

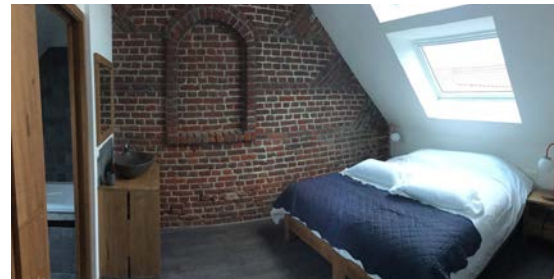
THE HOST & INSTRUCTOR
